SECONDARY CREDIT PROGRAM (Grades 9 to 12) 2020-2021

Opportunities to earn secondary language credits towards graduation.

Important Changes Regarding Program Delivery – September 2020

Due to the pandemic, International and Indigenous Language classes for grades 9 to Grade 12 students will take place online, not in the school buildings. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language class.

What does this mean? Your child will use Google classroom to see the teacher teach the live lesson during the regularly scheduled language class.

If a student is not able to participate in a live lesson during the regular scheduled class, alternative asynchronous support is provided to ensure the student has access to the online learning (e.g., posting of pre-recorded material or tasks for reference at a later time).

We look forward to providing engaging, online language learning through our Google Classrooms until normal in class language instruction resumes.

Fees

A \$20 consumable fee will be collected when schools re-open for International and Indigenous Language classes and normal in class language instruction resumes. International fee-paying visa students are required to pay an additional \$500 for registration, plus consumable fees.

Did you know there are many benefits to taking credit language courses?

- Students can take one International Languages Course as a Group 1- Compulsory or as an Elective Credit towards their Ontario Secondary Diploma.
- Students in the Secondary International Languages program can earn up to three credits towards graduation.
- If students successfully complete the Level D - University course, it can be used as one of their top six marks for post-secondary entry. For example, if a student takes Spanish Level B, C and D, the student can submit their Level D mark as one of the top six marks for post-secondary applications.

Please Note: Courses offered are subject to enrolment and teacher availability. Stacked classes may be created based on registration numbers. Additional fees are required for International fee-paying visa students. Non-YRDSB students will be enrolled only after all YRDSB students are placed.
