

## **Consent to Disclose Information for Students at the Age of Majority (Adult Students)**

A student who is 18 years old or older has reached the age of majority in Ontario. Adult students will assume full responsibility and decision making for all matters related to their education, academic programming, and related services.

Written consent is required for the school and/or York Region District School Board (YRDSB) to disclose an adult student's personal information to their parent(s) or legal guardian(s). By signing this form, the adult student consents to the school and/or the YRDSB to communicate and disclose information about their education, academic programming, and related services to their parent(s) or legal guardian(s). This includes, but is not limited to, information contained in the adult student's Ontario Student Record, report cards, parent teacher interviews, attendance information, academic progress, and other school communications.
