- 1. Select the following link to create an account and log in to BetterEducate platform https://bettereducate.com/yrdsb_application
- 2. Select the tile "School Administrator".



3. Create a username and password by completing the required fields and select Sign Up.

4. When you log in, you will see a dashboard with three tiles: YRDSB Leadership Framework for School Administrators 2020, Self Assessment and My Leadership Profile.



5. Access and review the YRDSB Leadership Framework for School Administrators 2020



6. Access the **Self Assessment** tile to begin your self assessment. Completing the self assessment is not mandatory for the application process; however, you may find completing the self assessment will support greater understanding of the YRDSB Leadership Framework for School Administrators.



7. Label your Self Assessment, example "Leadership" and select NEXT.



8. Select each domain to drop down to each competency to begin your self assessment. As you consider each *Action for Leader* described in the Self Assessment Tool, ask yourself to what extent you demonstrated each leadership action. Select the most suitable response rated 1 to 4.
