



DUAL CREDIT



Eligible senior students have an opportunity to take a first-year College level course while in high school. A dual credit course counts as one of your 3 or 4 courses in a semester. Classes run once a week and are offered through various colleges. Upon successful completion of the course, students earn ONE high school credit towards their OSSD, and ONE credit from the college delivering the course.
