



The Come Up Black Youth Internship Program

The Come Up in partnership with York University, presents the Black Internship Program. This program is designed to develop leadership skills for Black students and increase education engagement through skills development, experiential learning, and credit accumulation.

The program enables students to:

- Customize their secondary school education to suit their interests and skills
- Learn in a safe, supportive and Black affirming environment with like-minded staff and peers
- Explore and refine their academic & career goals
- Earn an co-op credit
- Engage in experiential & community based learning while getting paid

Students will be paid, earn 1 Coop credit, and receive a Leadership certification from York University.

- Are you a YRDSB student?
- Do you identify as Black?
- Are you entering grade 11 in September 2024?
- You must provide your SIN number upon registration.
