


## **Background**

- The new school site is located northeast of Wellington Street and Bayview Avenue at 11 Spring Farm Road in Aurora
- The scheduled opening date is September 2025


#### **Current Boundaries**



### **Proposed Boundary Change**




### **New Proposed Boundaries**




#### **Projection After Change**

## **Timing and Students Impacted**

- Boundary change effective starting September 2025 with the opening of the new Dr. G.W. Williams SS
- Current Grade 7 students who will be Grade 9 in September 2025
- Current Grade 8 students who have already selected their school for 2024 and students currently attending Dr. G.W. Williams SS from this area are not affected by this change

### **Student Transfers**

- Transfers are outlined in <u>Board Policy 108, Student</u> <u>Accommodations</u>.
- Schools open/closed to transfers from students who reside outside the attendance area are reviewed on an annual basis and are listed on the Board's <u>Secondary</u> <u>Schools Open/Closed to Transfers</u> webpage.

CEC West	Hodan Nalayeh SS (for French Immersion), Stephen Lewis SS, Tommy Douglas SS


# Transportation (Policy 680)

- Grades 9 to 12 a secondary student living more than 3.2 kilometres from the nearest secondary school in an area not served by public transit is eligible for Board-provided transportation
- Transit Served Student
  - A pupil of the Board who has access to public transit to travel to and/or from school and unless under exceptional circumstances:
    - lives within 1.2 kilometres from a public transit stop as measured by Student Transportation Services;
    - regularly spends 75 minutes or less traveling to or from school; and
    - requires no more than three vehicle transfers traveling to or from school.
- School bus transportation eligibility is reviewed annually as York Region Transit (YRT) adjusts and enhances service
- If eligible for Board-provided transportation, Student Transportation Services routes available August 2025 - <u>schoolbuscity.com</u> > Find Your Bus Stop
