

Trends

- Dr. G.W. Williams SS enrolment has been declining
 - ➤ Participation rates of Grade 8 students to Dr. G.W. Williams SS has been declining from all feeders
- The majority of residential units have been built in northeast Aurora
- Aurora HS enrolment has begun to grow





Summary of Issues in Aurora

Aurora HS French Immersion program will continue to grow

• Dr. G.W. Williams SS enrolment is declining

- East Aurora not attending Dr. G.W. Williams SS
 - ➤ Dr. G.W. Williams SS is not located in area of growth

Option A – Status Quo

- Dr. G.W. Williams SS:
 - ➤ Monitor enrolment (including new IB program)
 - ➤ Regular track participation rates from Aurora may not change
 - ➤ York Region Transit (YRT) service may remain the same
- Aurora HS:
 - ➤ Continued FI growth will create imbalance between regular track and FI enrolment

Option B – Boundary/Program Changes

- Dr. G.W. Williams SS:
 - Rebalance regular track enrolment between Aurora HS and Dr. G.W. Williams SS
 - ➤ Not enough feeders left at Aurora HS
 - Send east Aurora regular track to Newmarket HS
 - ➤ No space at Newmarket HS
 - Further reduces enrolment at Dr. G.W. Williams SS
 - Send east Oak Ridges regular track to Dr. G.W.
 Williams SS
 - Short term solution as a new secondary school is required to serve the community of Oak Ridges

Option B – Boundary/Program Changes

- Dr. G.W. Williams SS:
 - Explore adding more programs to Dr. G. W.
 Williams SS in addition to Gifted and IB
 - > French Immersion
 - > Arts
 - ➤ No more than 2 Regional programs to ensure balance between regular track and program enrolment

Option B – Boundary/Program Changes

- Aurora HS:
 - Due to French Immersion growth from Oak Ridges feeders, explore alternatives, to be determined under a separate boundary change process

Option C – Build a 3rd Secondary School

Build a 3rd secondary school in northeast
 Aurora on the Board owned site

Issue:

Long term projections for Aurora HS and Dr. G.W. Williams SS show the need for only 2 public secondary schools in the Town of Aurora

Option C – Build a 3rd Secondary School

- Population will increase from 56,000 to 80,000 over a 25 year time frame (2016 census, York Region 2041 Preferred Growth Scenario)
- Secondary schools typically need 4 6 elementary feeders to support enrolment
 - ➤ The growth to 2041 would not require 4 6 additional elementary schools
- This growth can be accommodated in existing secondary schools within the Town of Aurora
 - ➤ Dr. G.W. Williams is at 57% utilization

Option D – Relocate Dr. G. W. Williams SS


 Explore relocating Dr. G. W. Williams SS to the Board owned site located in northeast Aurora

 Potentially include project on the 2017 Capital Strategy Project List scheduled for June 13, 2017 Property Management Committee

 The Board could apply for funding in Summer 2017 from the Ministry of Education to relocate the school

Option D – Relocate Dr. G. W. Williams SS

- Enrolment continues to shift from west to east (of Industrial Parkway)
- There will be challenges obtaining Ministry funding
- If approved:
 - > the potential opening of a relocated secondary school would not occur for a number of years,
 - proposing to retain the Dr. G. W. Williams SS building,
 - undertake a boundary review process to address the southwestern portion of the school boundary
