FSL Review

- **Goal:** To achieve high quality, sustainable French language instruction in YRDSB
- **Outcomes:**
 - Consistency of programming
 - Toolkit to address need for FI spaces and enable long-term accommodation plan

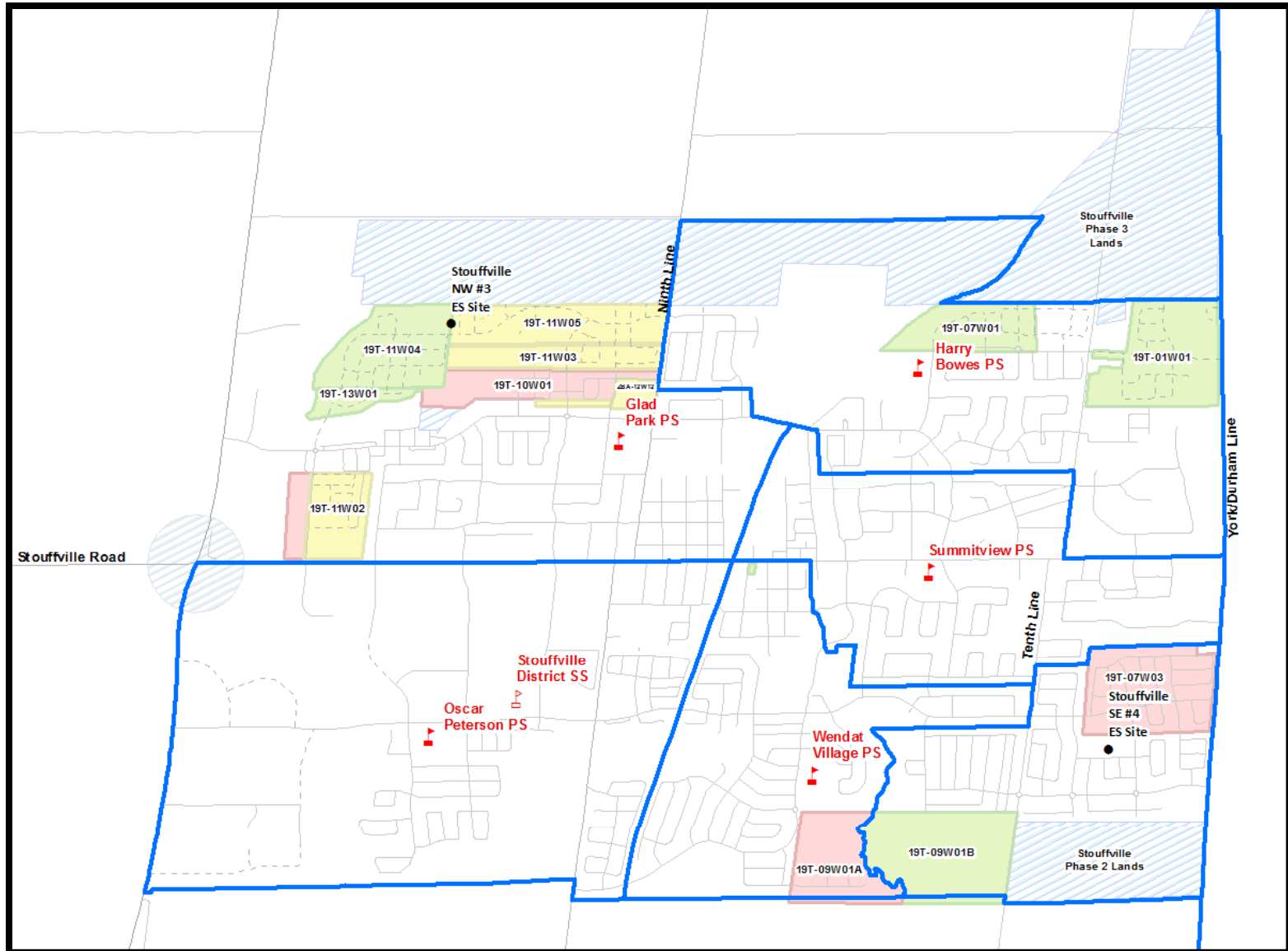
FI Accommodation Model

- Maintain Grade 1 entry and no capping
- FI program offered in a variety of settings
 - Single Track
 - Dual Track
 - * NEW* Primary Dual Track
 - Grade(s): 1 – 2, 1 – 3
- This allows flexibility needed to address local needs across region
- Ministry will not fund Board for empty pupil places

Proposal

- Create a Primary Dual Track at Summitview PS in 2014 for incoming grade 1 French Immersion students from the Glad Park PS FI boundary
- Students would stay for grade 2 French Immersion at Summitview PS in 2015
- In 2016 students would move to Glad Park PS for French Immersion grades 3-8

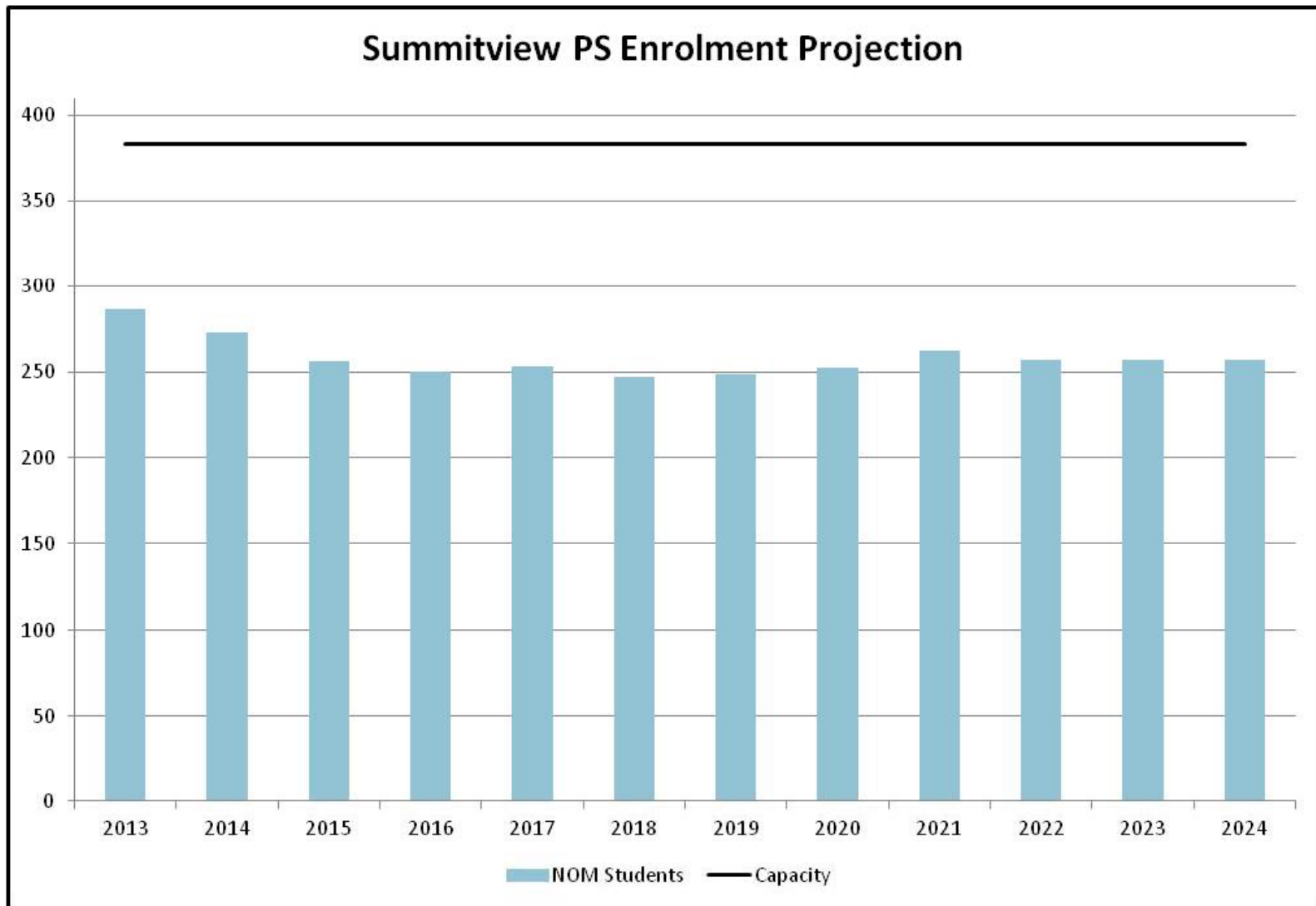

Before & After Care

Transportation (Policy 680.0)

 - JK-3 students live >1.2km from school
 - Grade 4-8 students >1.6km from school
