

Current Cornell Village Boundary and Holding






Development in Cornell

- Within the Proposed Cornell Village PS boundary, there is very little development remaining except for a pocket of infill development (<30 units)
- In the proposed Cornell NE ES boundary, about 40% of the total proposed units have been built
- In the proposed Cornell SE ES boundary, only a handful of units have been built (~60 units)

Proposal

- Cornell Village PS boundary be split to create new boundaries for Cornell Village PS, Cornell NE and Cornell SE
- Implementation beginning in September 2012, with all students in Cornell NE and Cornell SE boundaries attending the new Cornell NE school
- Students in the proposed Cornell Village PS boundary currently holding at Little Rouge PS will return to Cornell Village PS in 2012
- Current Grade 6 students who are attending Cornell Village PS and within the new Cornell NE boundary be allowed to stay in 2012 to graduate with their classmates at Cornell Village PS

January 17, 2011: School Council Meeting


February 1, 2011: Public Meeting to be held at Cornell Village PS

March 2011: Take recommended boundary change to Board Standing and Board for final approval


