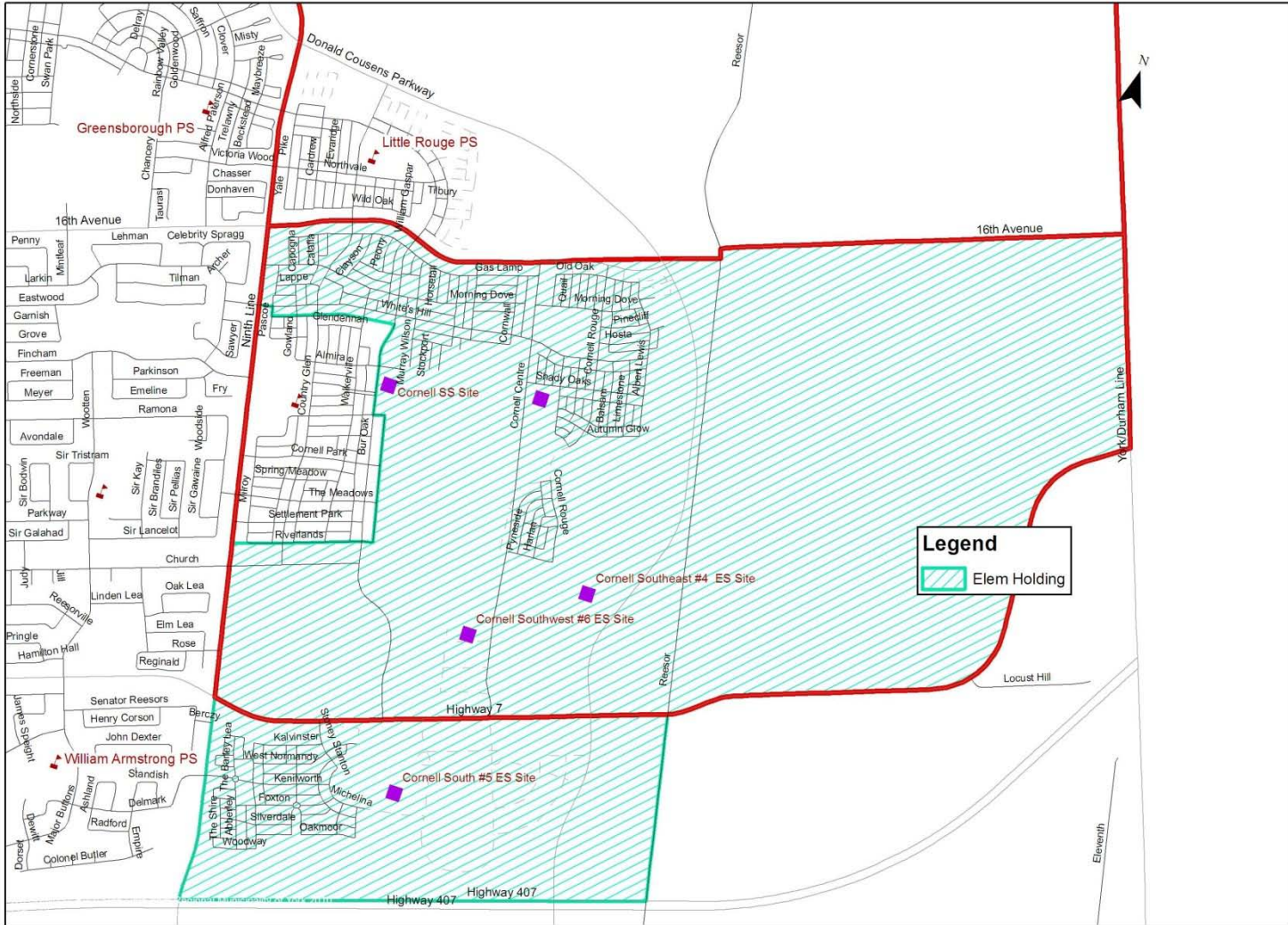

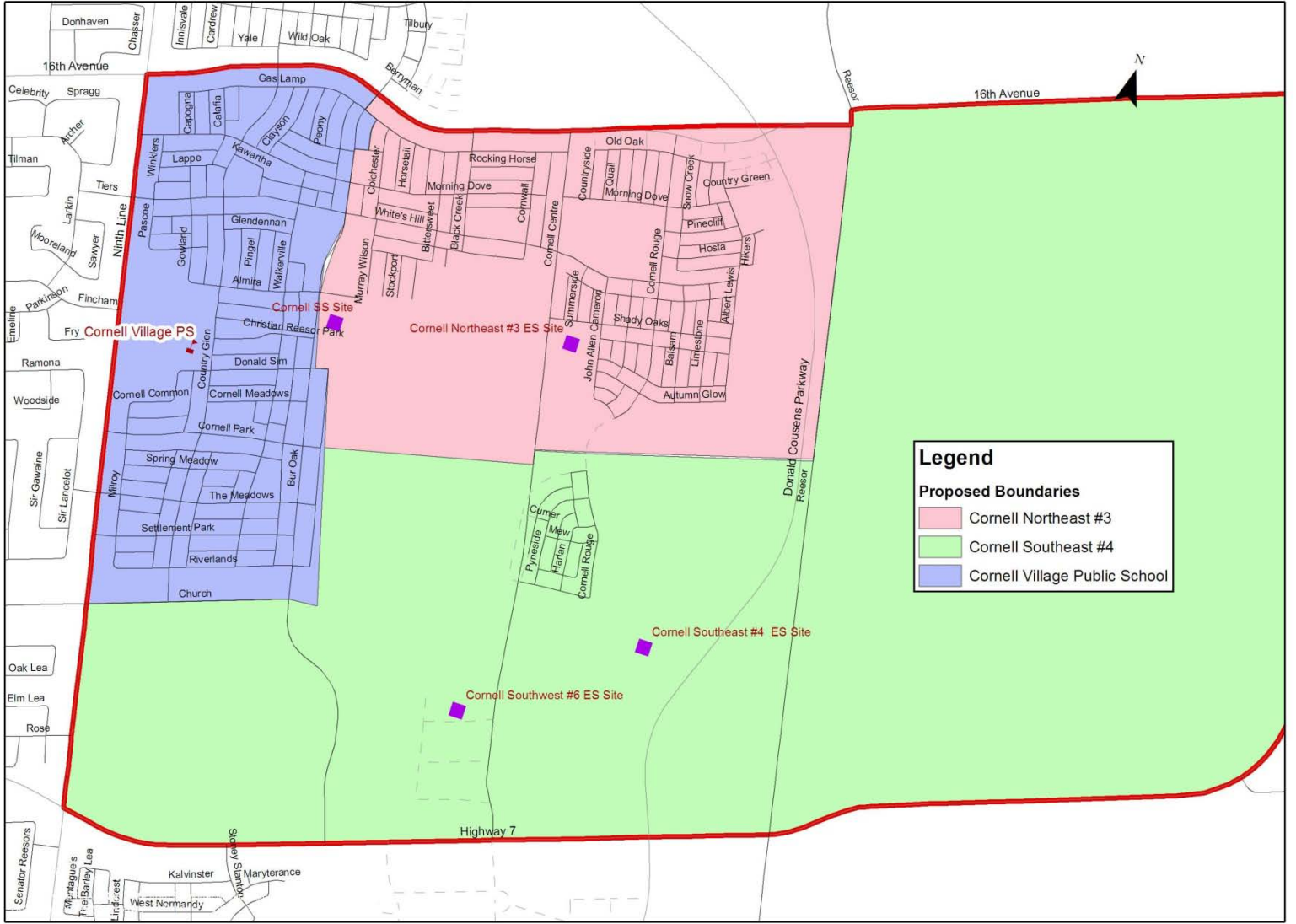

Proposed Boundaries

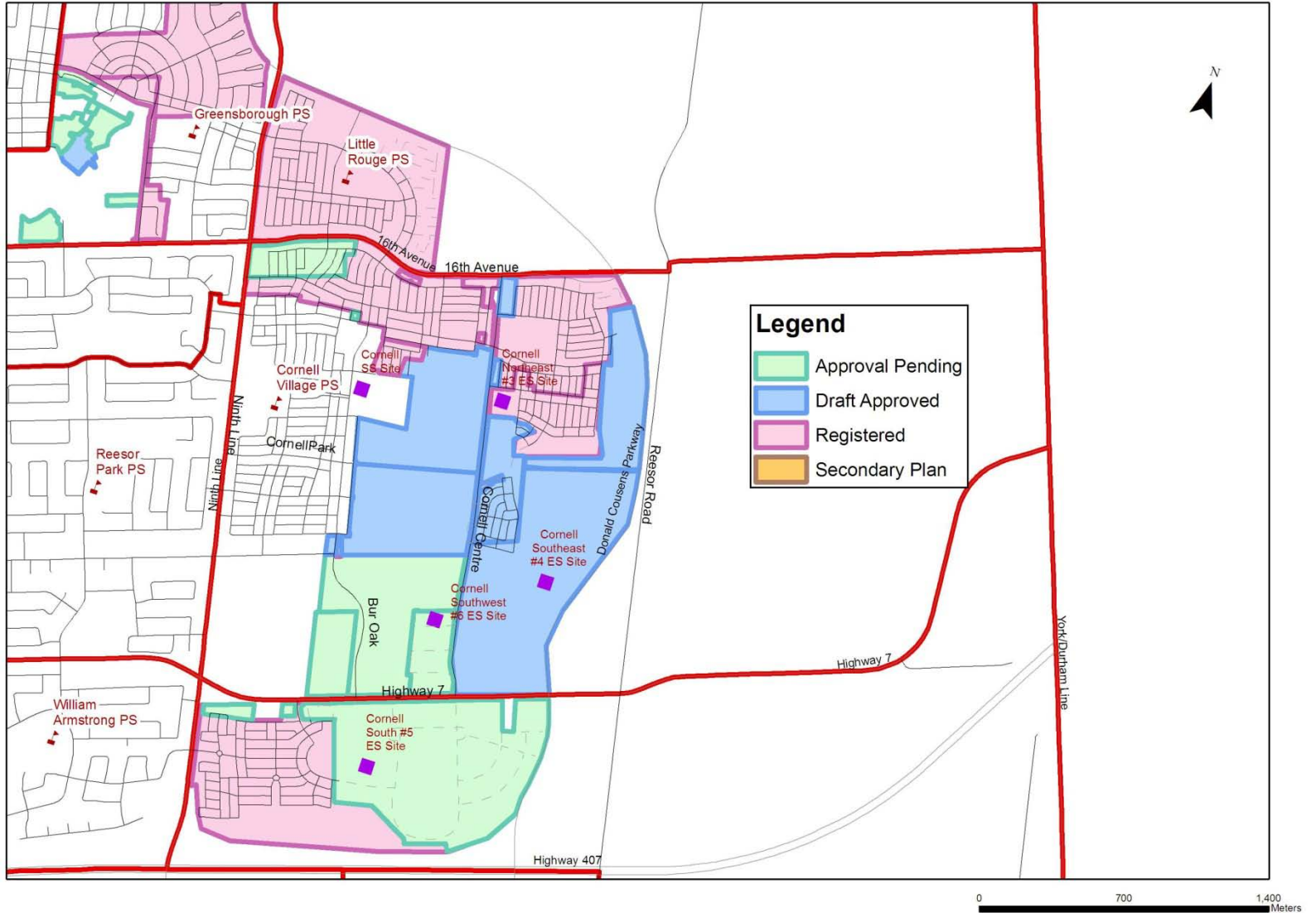
- Cornell Northeast #3

Development in Little Rouge Boundary/ William Armstrong – Sec B Boundary

- Within the Little Rouge PS boundary, there are approximately 434 units of residential development remaining in submitted development applications
- Currently there are approximately 675 units built within Little Rouge PS boundary
- In William Armstrong – Section B boundary, approximately 539 units have been built
 - There are approximately 4,000 high density units remaining in the boundary in development applications awaiting approval

Implementation

- Cornell Village PS boundary be split into 3 boundaries effective September 2011
- Implementation in September 2012, with all students in Cornell NE and Cornell SE boundaries attending the new Cornell NE school
- Students from within the new Cornell Village PS boundary will attend Cornell Village PS
- Current Grade 6 students who are attending Cornell Village PS and within the new Cornell NE boundary be allowed to stay in 2012 to graduate with their classmates at Cornell Village PS

Implementation

- Students currently in Grade 6 from the Cornell Village PS boundary holding at Little Rouge PS will be given the choice to stay at Little Rouge in 2012 to graduate with their classmates.

Process

- January 17, 2011: Cornell Village School Council Meeting
- February 1, 2011: Public Meeting held at Cornell Village PS
- February 2011: Take recommended boundary change to Programming Planning Committee
- March 2011: Take recommended boundary change to Board Standing and Board for final approval
