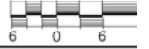
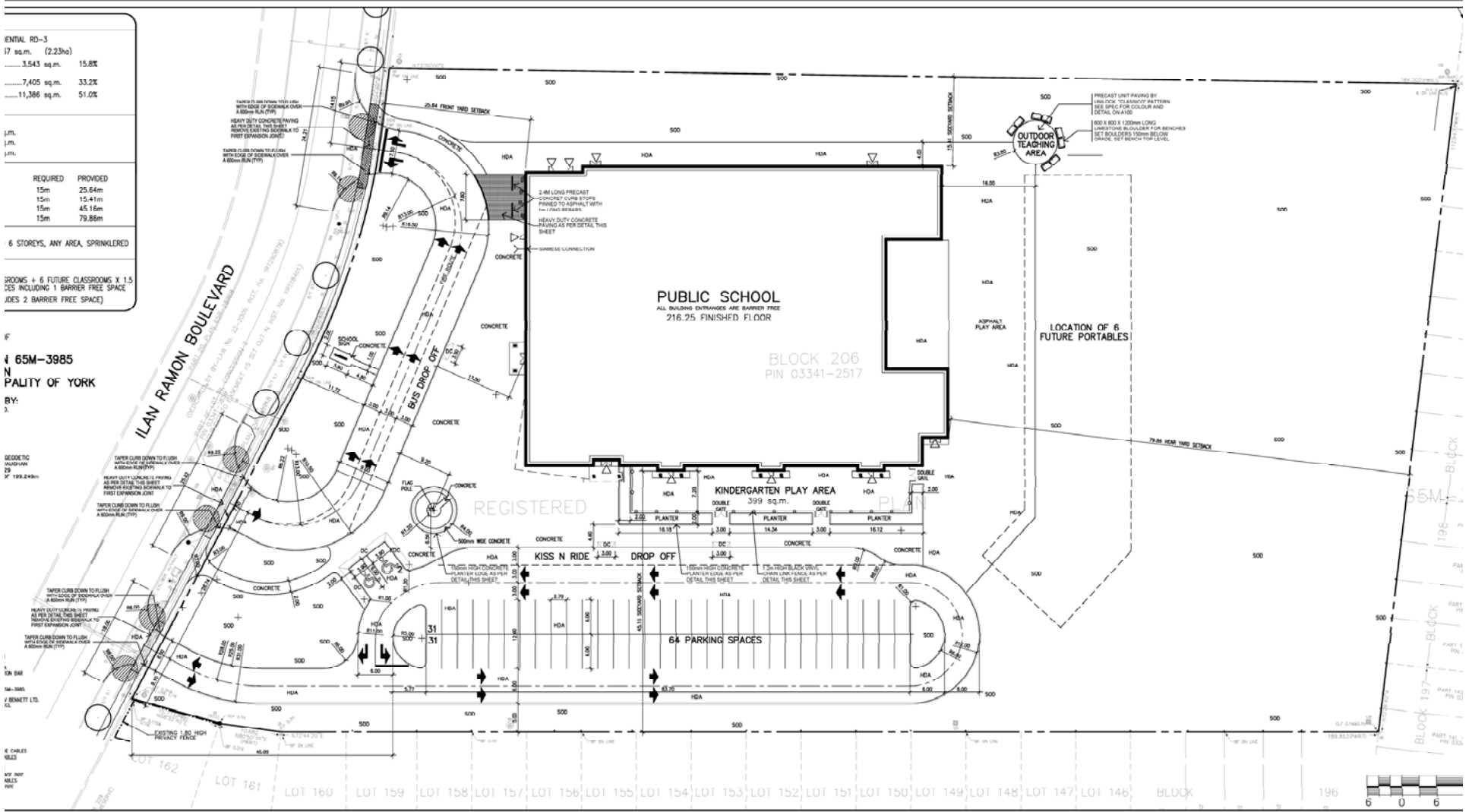

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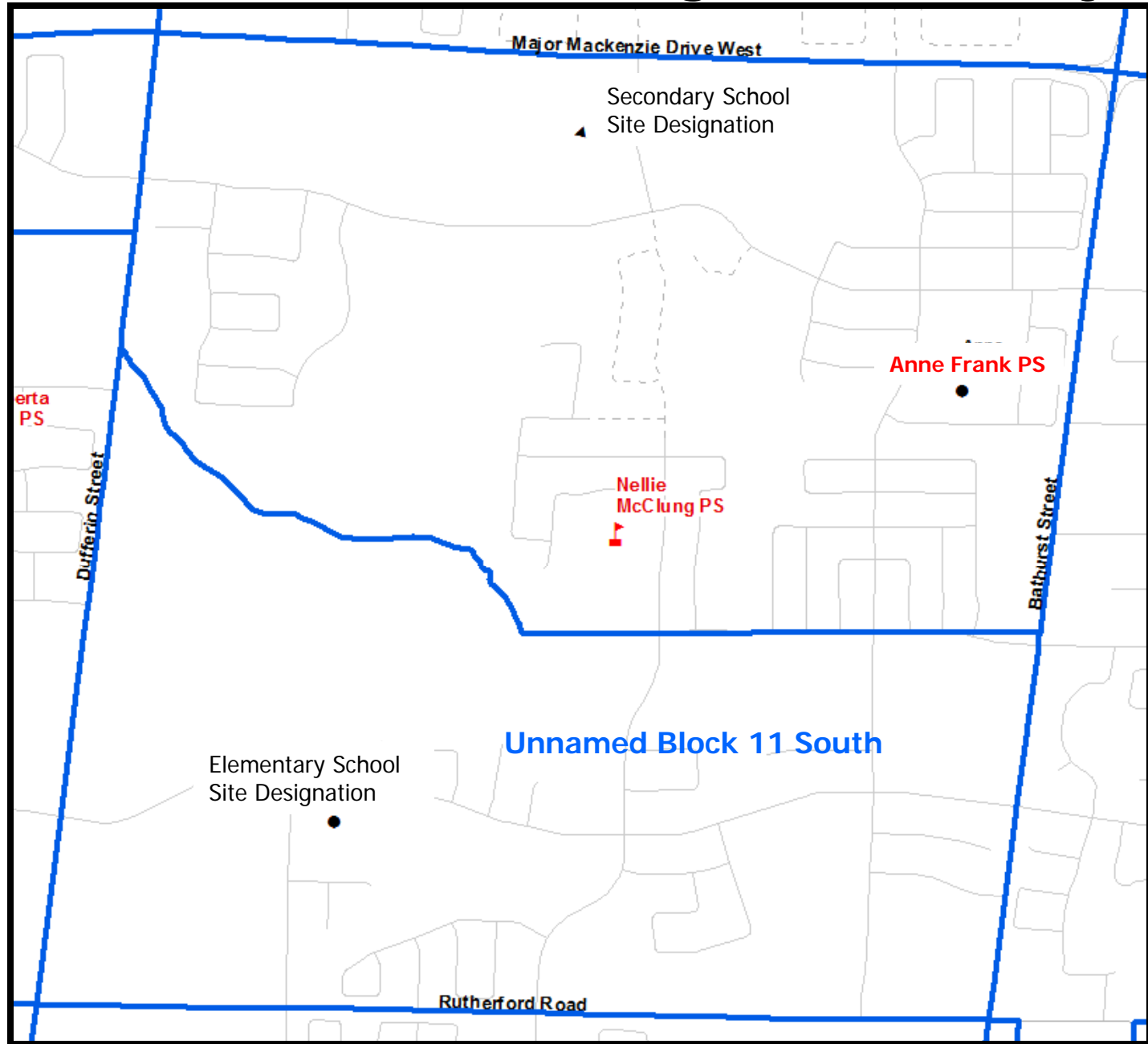


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Establishing a Boundary

- Boundaries are created for long term sustainable enrolment of a school
- Follow major features such as:
 - Hard dividers like roads, railways
 - Natural dividers like rivers, green spaces, etc.
 - Parcels
- Non-transportation zone or 'walkability'
- Future residential development
- Student yields
- Long term student projections

Current Nellie McClung PS Boundary

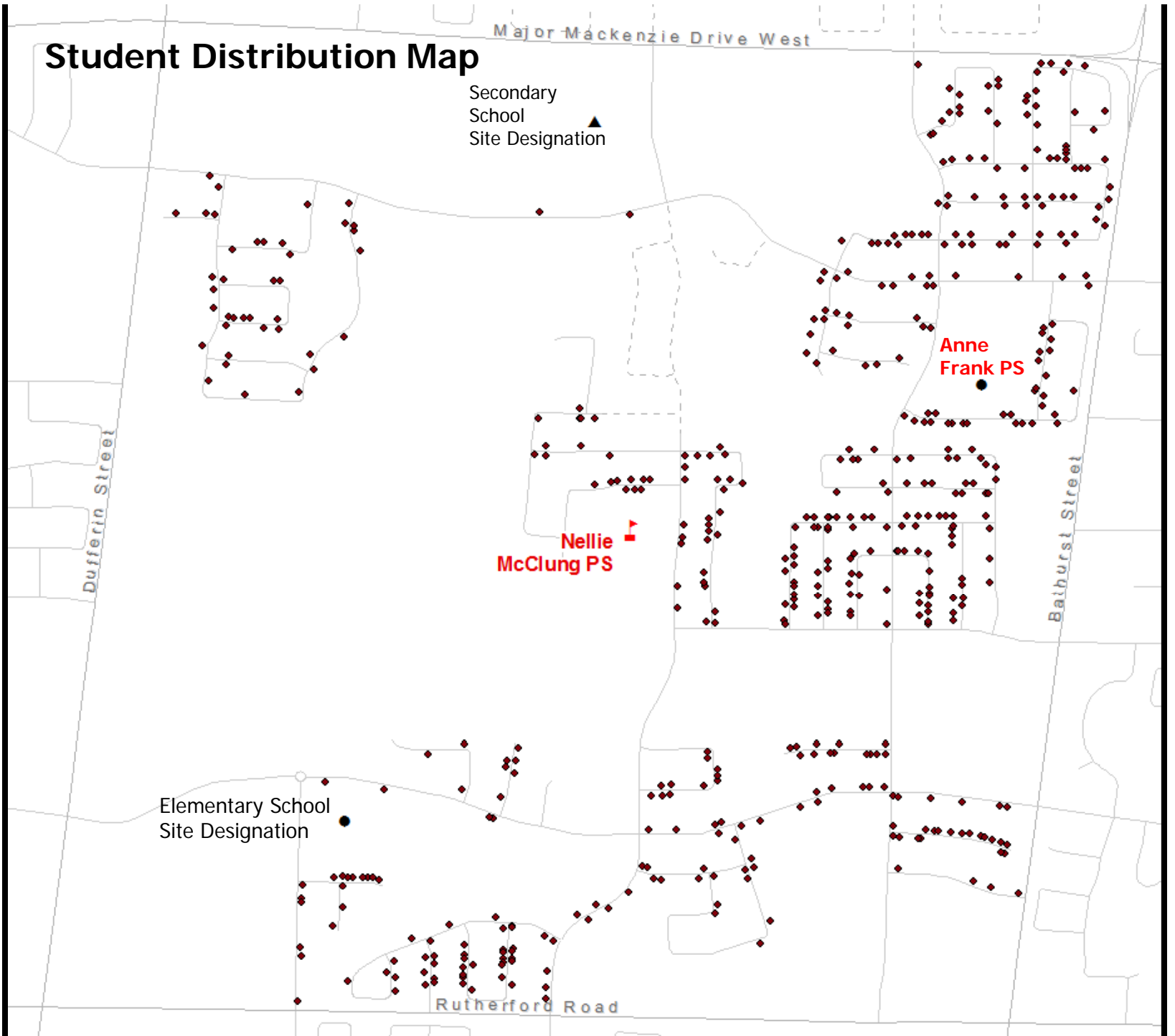


Unnamed Block 11 South

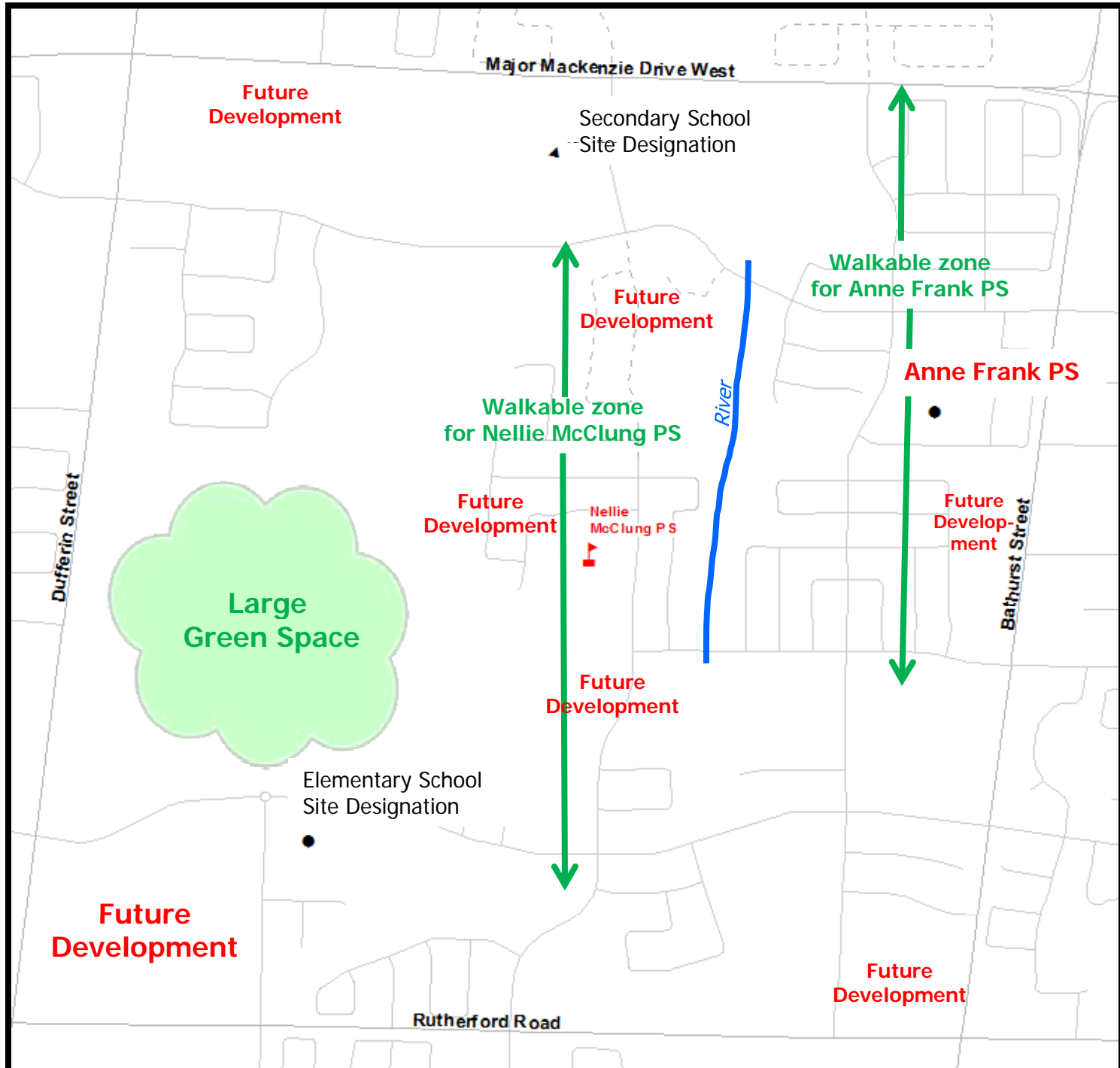
- Two elementary school site designations in Block 11
- The block 11 south boundary was created in 2005
- The north site was chosen to be built as a school because more students could walk to school, and the site is located within a large cluster of students
- This boundary review will eliminate the Block 11 south boundary and have two operating school boundaries
- The third site will be evaluated if needed for future school accommodation

York Region District School Board

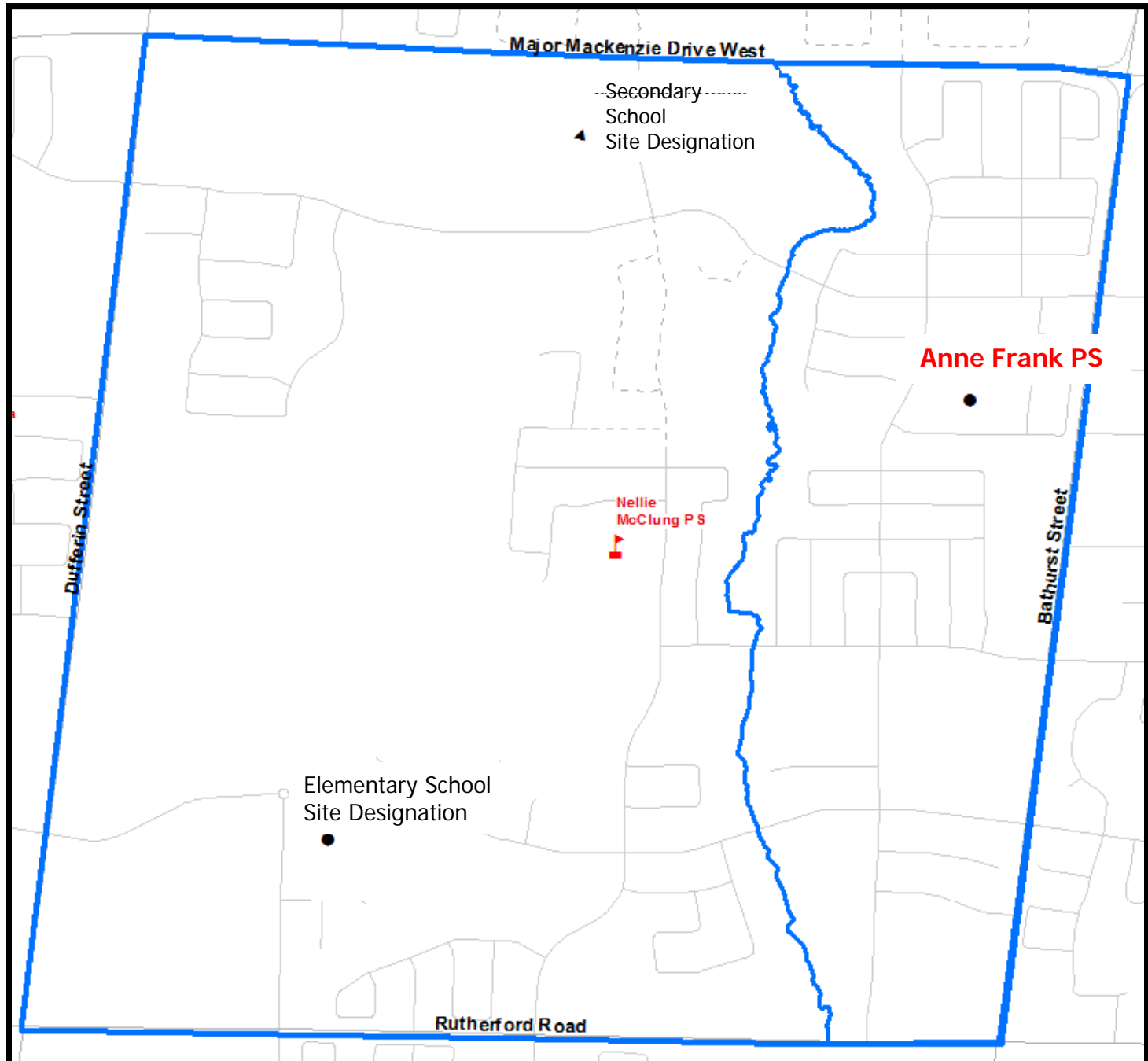
Student Distribution Map



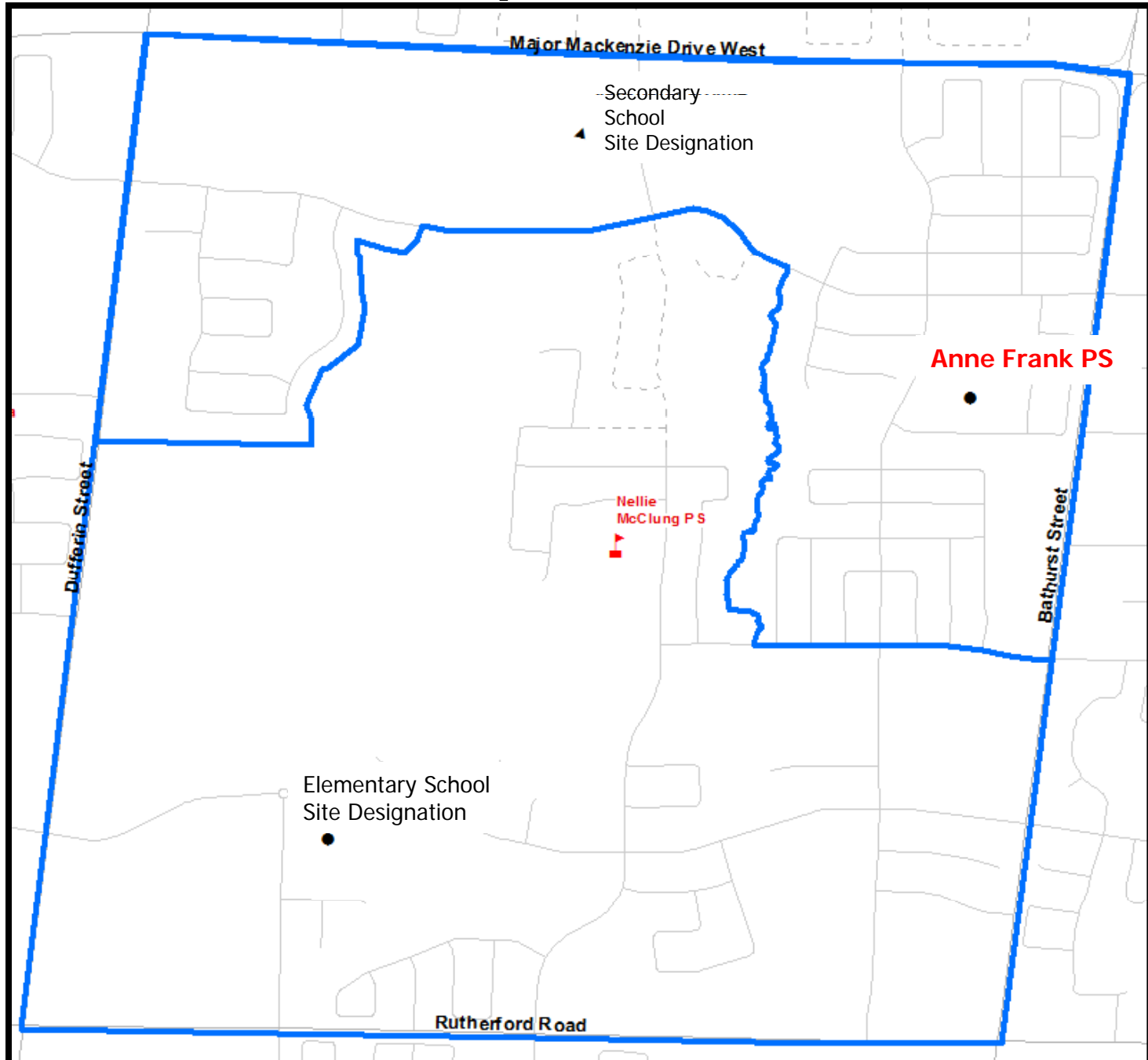

New Elementary Boundary

- Staff will be recommending Option 2 as the preferred option to the Board
- Option 2 is preferred due to:
 - Long term enrolment stability for community
 - Balance of projected school enrolments in the long term
 - More of a balanced mix of different types of housing units due to differing pupil yields

Secondary School Attendance

New School Planning

- There are three requirements to proceed with a new school project
 - 1. Land**
 - The Board has a secondary school site designation in Block 11 for future school need
 - We do not own this land at this time
 - We do have an option to purchase this site if required

New School Planning

2. Students

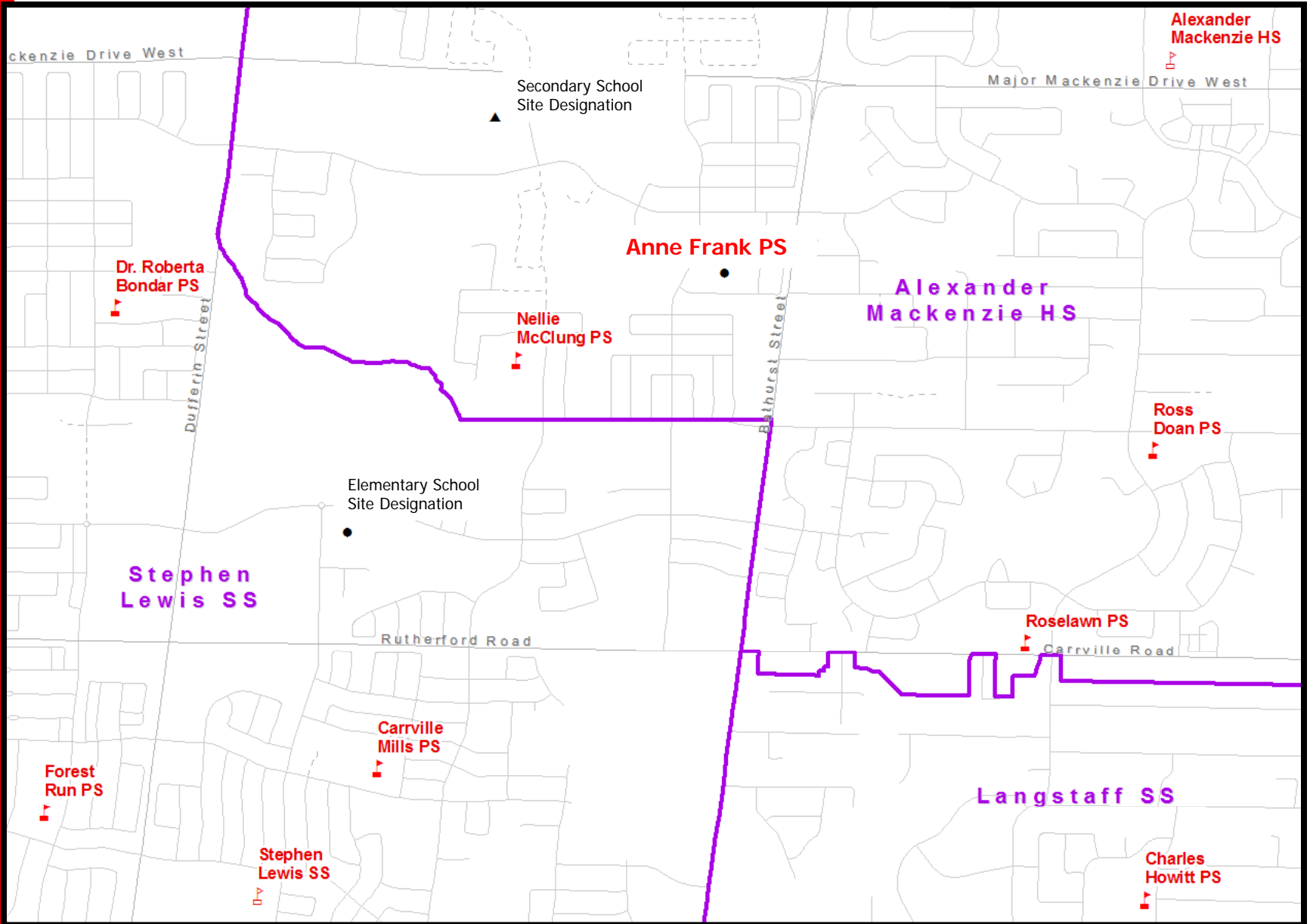
- Students need to be attending existing public secondary schools in the surrounding area
- Cannot 'bank' on future students in lower elementary grades or students from other Boards/private schools

New School Planning

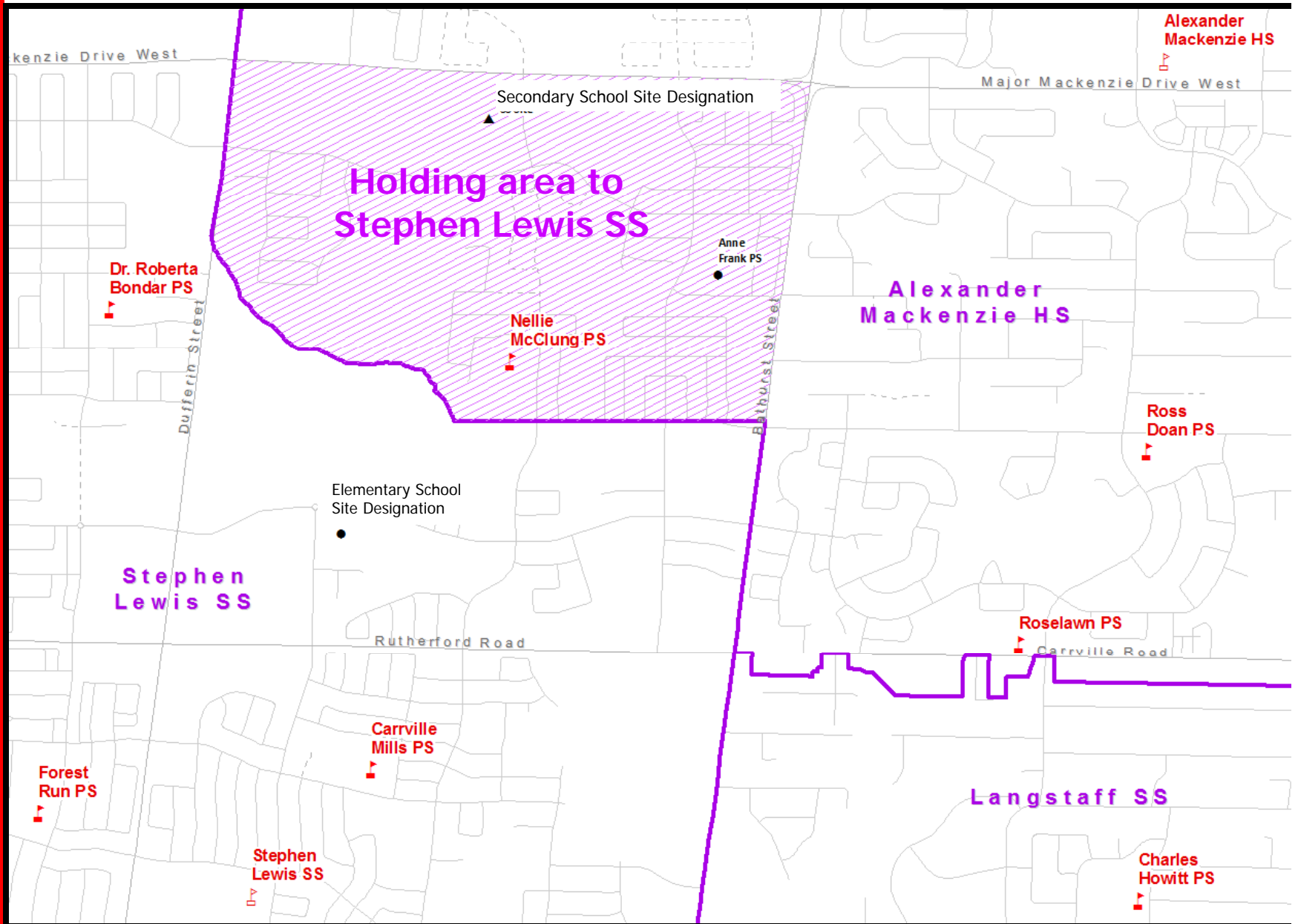
3. Funding from the Ministry of Education

- This is achieved by creating a business case to show we have little/no accommodation options for existing students in the surrounding area
- A substantial number of students for potential new school need to be accommodated in holding locations or portables
- Submissions are for specific school year openings
- New school funding is decreasing across the province

Building a Case

- By increasing enrolment at Stephen Lewis SS, we are taking the first step in building a business case
- The business case will take many years as there is capacity at Alexander Mackenzie HS
- Our Board has submitted a business case to the Ministry three times for a new secondary school in Markham for September 2017
- No other new secondary schools will be approved prior to that timeframe
