Secondary FI Program

- FI program commenced at Pierre Elliott Trudeau HS in 2002
 - Only location serving City of Markham and portion of Stouffville
 - Oct. 31, 2014 FI enrolment:

Grade 9	Grade 10	Grade 11	Grade 12	Total
146	136	92	95	469

- FI program is projected to continue to grow
- An additional FI secondary program is required due to:
 - Residential development in North Markham and Stouffville
 - Addition of elementary programs
 - Sir Wilfrid Laurier PS (2007)
 - Sam Chapman PS (2010)

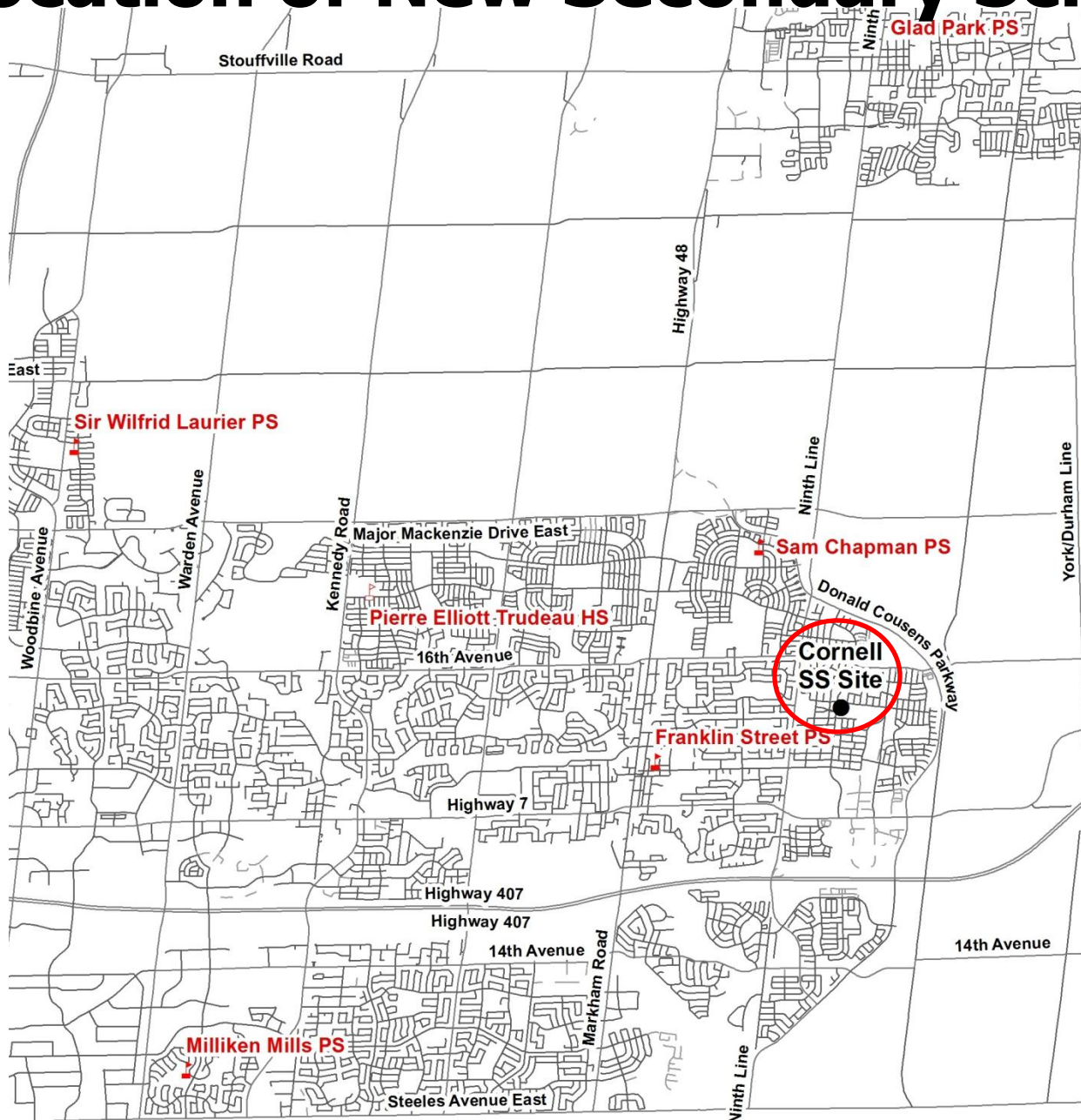
Evaluation of Secondary School Location for New Program

- Bill Crothers SS – Athletics program
- Bur Oak SS – holding for Cornell area
- Markham DHS – Gifted program
- Markville SS – Gifted program
- Stouffville DHS – residential growth
- Unionville HS – Arts program
- Middlefield CI, Milliken Mills HS – located in South Markham
 - Threshold for FI program in South Markham is still small

Secondary School Location for New Program

- A new secondary school will be opening in the Cornell area (16th Avenue and Ninth Line) in September 2017
- This new secondary school will serve the local area for regular programming and will serve a portion of FI from Pierre Elliott Trudeau HS

Location of New Secondary School

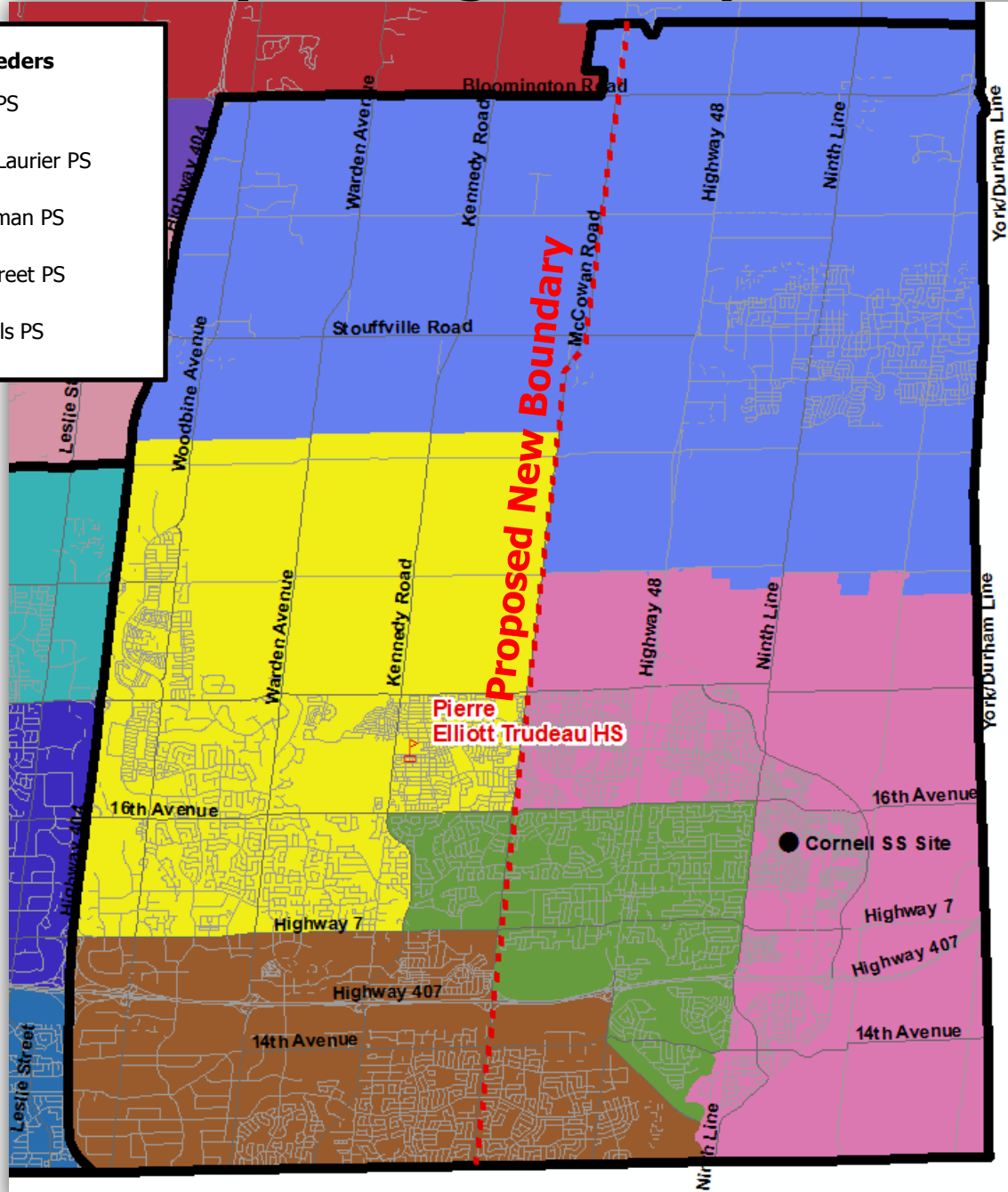


East of Bur Oak Avenue, south of Almira Avenue

Why Use McCowan Road Instead of Elementary Feeders?

- Proximity of students to each secondary school
- Using McCowan Road gives Pierre Elliott Trudeau HS accommodation relief
- Secondary Gifted program for Markville SS and Markham DHS will also be using McCowan Road

Timing and Students Impacted

- Begin the FI program at Unnamed Cornell SS in September 2017
 - New incoming Grade 9 FI students and;
 - Grade 10 FI students from the proposed boundary area (east of McCowan Road)
- Current FI students impacted are:
 - Grade 6's who will be Grade 9 in September 2017
 - Grade 7's who will be Grade 10 in September 2017
 - Will be required to be relocated to Unnamed Cornell SS for FI for grades 10-12

Transfers

- Transfers are outlined in our Board policy 108: Attendance Areas and Transfers
- Pierre Elliott Trudeau HS was closed to transfers in 2014-15 for regular programming
- Schools open/closed to transfers is reviewed on an annual basis

Transportation

- Transportation provided as per policy 680
 - Grades 9 to 12 – a secondary school student living in an area served by public transit is not eligible for Board-provided transportation
 - A secondary student living more than 3.2 kilometres from the nearest secondary school in an area not served by public transit is eligible for Board-provided transportation
- School bus transportation eligibility is reviewed annually as York Region Transit (YRT) adjusts and enhances service
